CFC for BI Waiver Members



Community First Choice (CFC) is a new program you can access in addition to your waiver. CFC allows some services that were only in specific waivers to be available to anyone who needs them regardless of how they access Medicaid. CFC also expands how you can access those services.

More services and more options to more people!



Am I eligible for CFC?

Anyone who qualifies for the BI waiver is eligible for CFC also.

Who will help me?

Your case manager will walk you through the process, options, and any needed assessments when you do your annual waiver renewal meeting.

When can I add CFC?

At your next waiver renewal starting July 1, 2025

Do I have to add CFC?

Some services you may already be using like personal care are moving so to keep using those services you will need to add CFC.

What's Changing for BI Members?

The following services will be moved from the waiver to CFC or added as new CFC services:

- Moved: Personal Care, Homemaker, Home Delivered Meals, Medication Reminder, Personal Emergency Response Systems, Remote Services, Transition Set Up.
- Added: Acquisition, Maintenance and Enhancement of Skills (AME); Health Maintenance Activities

Current waiver members will transition to CFC for these services at the time of their scheduled renewal (Continued Stay Review) between 7/1/25-6/30/26. Services will continue to be available through waivers until the member transitions to CFC.
